WHERE DO I GO FOR HELP?

There are many different people available and willing to help you with any worries and difficulties you may experience. These may include homesickness, health worries, bereavement, work crises, relationship problems, home tensions, inappropriate relationships or bullying.

One of the best ways of dealing with problems is to share them with someone you can trust. It is a sign of strength and common sense to do this.

You will often seek and receive help from your Housemaster or Housemistress, your Tutor or your House Matron.

The Senior Nurse or her Assistants are on duty 24 hours a day in the Health Centre. It is necessary, however, to observe the published times for routine surgery matters. The nurses can arrange consultations with the doctor who in turn can draw on the full range of specialist medical treatment.

The Chaplain lives on campus and is used to helping with all manner of concerns. Outside of normal rounds, he can be contacted confidentially via the [locked] letter-box in the outside door of the Athens Room or at his home by telephone: 0118 984 3937.

The Headmaster lives on campus and can be found in his study most evenings.

The Deputy Head Pastoral [DSL], Mrs Bond, can be found in her classroom SA03, or her office in Study Area near Common Room and can be contacted via her email caroline.bond@pangbourne.com, her mobile 07766 578617 in the first instance or at home on 01189 845297.

The other Deputy Headmasters, Mr Bancroft [DDSL] and Mr Williams, are always ready to listen and to help.

The Pastoral Welfare Committee meets once a month to address matters of general concern. You are represented by a member of your Division and Year.

However, there might well be occasions when you wish to talk to someone else. Here are a few suggestions of people to whom you could talk in confidence:

Vicky Wenham

Vicky Wenham is an experienced young people's counsellor whom you can talk to in confidence. She is available from 13:00 - 15:00 on Tuesdays in the Health Centre. You can email Vicky on vicky.wenham@pangbourne.com, book an appointment to see her through the Health Centre or Mrs Bond, or just turn up.

Peer Mentors

A group of Sixth Formers have been specially trained to help students with concerns and worries that occur in the everyday school environment. For more information on how to contact them, see the posters in your Division and around College.

COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE

The College has a formal complaints policy that is published on the pangbourne.com website. The policy lays out the steps that will be taken when a complaint is made. The first actions will always be to try to find an informal agreement and the procedure on this page aims to lay out the available pathways for informal complaints to be raised. If the informal complaint does not get resolved, the Complaints Policy gives the detail of the next level of procedure.

- i. Hand in a written complaint [with OR without telling the person about whom you are complaining], giving as many details as you can, to your Housemaster, a Deputy Head [Mr Williams, Mrs Bond or Mr Bancroft], the Chaplain, or the Headmaster. Mark it "COMPLAINT".
- ii. It will then be given to the Headmaster with whom, or with a person whom he chooses, you will be asked to talk the matter through. You may invite another pupil or a member of staff of your choice to come to this meeting with you.
- iii. It will then be decided whether or not to refer your complaint to a panel consisting of FOUR or more of the following: the Headmaster, a Deputy Head [Mr Williams, Mrs Bond or Mr Bancroft], the Chaplain, a nominated Teacher, and a Governor.
- iv. Your complaint will be taken seriously and handled promptly. The meeting with the Headmaster will take place within one week of your complaint being formally made. His decision over how best to proceed will then be made known to you within forty-eight hours.
