The judgements in the inspection are based on positive pupil outcomes. Key findings in the report concluded that both pupils' personal development and achievements were excellent. Key extracts from the report for each of these categories are highlighted below.

- Pupils write with fluency and **articulate challenging concepts** with confidence and clarity.
